The Government of Nepal has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Nepal India Regional Trade and Transport Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services. The scope of the consulting services is for **Geotechnical Investigation, Detail Design and Construction Supervision of Landslide Stabilization Works in Narayanghat - Mugling Road**. Anticipated date for commencement of the services is November 2018 and the tentative duration of the assignment is about 9 months.

The consulting services ("the Services") include Detail Geotechnical Investigation, Topographic Survey of vulnerable road slopes, detail design and Construction Supervision of Landslide Stabilization Works.

Nepal India Regional Trade and Transport Project, Development Cooperation Implementation Division, Department of Roads under the Ministry of Physical Infrastructure and Transport now invites eligible Consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The short listing criteria are:

- Business Objective and Expertise of the Firm.
- Corporate Capacity of the Firm (Annual Turnover for last 5 years)
- General Work Experience of the Firm.
- Similar Work experience of the Consulting Firm and its complexity, similar geographical experience.
- Adherence to the code of ethics and Government's anticorruption policy

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, dated January 2011 ("Consultant Guidelines") setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications.

A consultant will be selected in accordance with the Selection Based on the Consultants' Qualifications (CQS) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines, Dated January 2011.
