

CHINA'S CHOKEHOLD CHALLENGE

Namibia's Construction Industries Federation and the Metal & Allied Namibian Workers Union have launched an online protest against the impending award of a N\$300-m contract of the Karib-Usakos road upgrade to a Chinese contractor after local companies were sidelined in the tender pre-qualification process.

It is a foregone conclusion that a Chinese company will be rehabilitating the road from Karibib to Usakos, with Namibian sub-contractors feeding on scraps on the N\$300-m project that is not listed in Namibia's development

budget but is funded through a loan from Germany's KfW Development Bank that Namibia has to repay

he Roads Authority, which is implementing the project, issued a tender in mid-May inviting Namibian companies to approach the seven prequalified companies - all Chinese - for subcontracts.

A joint media release by the CIF and MANWU last week announced the launch of their campaign to have the tender for the TR7/1 road upgrade between Karib and Usakos cancelled.

"Notwithstanding the efforts by Namibia's Roads Authority to justify

the shortlisting of seven foreign companies, after the prequalification phase for the 32km road rehabilitation project, CIF and MANWU are dismayed that the second phase of the tender for the road upgrade goes ahead.
"This is despite Namibian authorities

and stakeholders being fully aware of the implications for the local construction

sector", the statement adds.
"At the same time, the CIF and MANWU remain very concerned about the state of Namibia's construction industry, and again recently engaged

authorities, requesting that changes the industry will take place immediately

"With no meaningful reaction from the state, the CIF and MANWU now escalate efforts and take to the internet for the public to become more aware and for relevant authorities to hear them

The statement goes on to report that most recent attempts to engage the authorities during the first two weeks of June 2023, included joint letters by the CIF and MANWU that had appealed to president Hage Geingob, prime minister Saara Kuugongelwa-Amadhila, minister of works and transport John Mutorwa and senior cabinet members.

The Roads Authority, the KfW and the German embassy were also approached in writing, together with the African Development Bank.

Attempts also included to lobby lawmakers, the speakers of both houses of parliament, as well as the leaders of opposition parties.

Repeated lobbying over many years for changes in favour of greater local participation in the construction sector have led to nothing and the short-listing of seven Chinese contractors for the Karibib-Usakos road project appears to have been last straw, prompting the two organisations representing employers and employees in the construction sector to launch their online campaign on 22 June for "urgent changes in Namibia's construction sector"

Aims of the protest

The protest campaign embodies several demands:

- that the project for the road upgrade between Usakos and Karibib is cancelled immediately and re-advertised in smaller lots, and that the technical specifications be reviewed;
- * that there will be a deliberate effort to engage majority Namibian-owned contractors on al infrastructure and building projects and that projects will be sized accordingly;
- that the government will play its part in creating an environment for decent work in the construc-tion sector ensuring that maximum employment opportunities are created for Namibian workers:
- that the government supports the "optimal development" of the construction sector prioritizing majority-Namibian-owned SMEs, majority Namibian-owned mid-sized contractors and majority Namibian-owned large-size contractors over foreign contractors or non-majority Namib-ian-owned contractors;
- that joint ventures between majority Namibianowned contractors must be given preference;
- that "tenderpreneurism" will not be permitted any further; and
- * that the government commits itself to the estab-lishment of construction council as soon as possible, which would be "in the interest of both the private sector as well as the public sector".

The online protest

The peaceful online protest was launched on the CIF's Facebook page with the intent of creating further public awareness of the state of the construction sector "and the lack of support the local industry receives from

the Namibian government".

According to the CEO of the CIF, Bärbel Kirchner: "Everyone is encouraged to enter the competition and upload their own protest poster and message in support of bona fide local

civil and building contractors.

"This is for the maintenance of an important sector of Namibia's economy and for the support of local construction and building businesses, as well as their employees and their families.

It is impossible that our local contractors are being displaced when we have our own capacity

The online protest will take place in the form of a Facebook competition. Entrants are encouraged to use the hashtag #supportourcontractors. At the same time, the competition pages and any positive related comments can be liked and shared and relevant authorities can be tagged.

Ideally, every peaceful protestor or entrant of the #supportourcontractors

competition, tags the MANWU page on Facebook and tags the pages of other key authorities and stakeholders including the personal pages of all relevant and associated civil servants and senior politicians.

The competition will run until end of July 2023.

Secretary-general of MANWU, Justina Jonas, said: "Both MANWU and CIF have tried just about everything to convince the authorities, but they are not hearing us.

"It is going on for far too long. Our workers are losing jobs because our local businesses do not have enough work. We talk and talk but no changes are happening.

"We are tired. Why should foreign companies get the work that our bona fide local contractors can do? There is no place for foreign contractors, except and only then when there really is no local capacity.

"How can you have foreign companies operate in the space where our own SMEs, our own mid-sized contractors and or own large-size contractors should operate.

"They infiltrate the Namibian construction sector at every level until there is not a single local contractor

"Government should take the lead in supporting local businesses. Otherwise it appears that government is not taking this seriously at all".

Kirchner added: "The CIF and MANWU strongly urge the Namibian Government to affect the proposed changes for the Namibian construction industry, in order not only to ensure its survival, maintaining and building of capacity in the sector, but also in the interest of the economy at large

"Any form of public procurement should not only have development role in terms of the infrastructure and building development but also in view of creating employment and addressing

poverty.
"The engagement of foreign contractors will not be able to achieve the same, and may even be in contradiction of existing policies of our Government, and will have disadvantageous macroeconomic implications.

The CIF and MANWU added that it was necessary to embark on this campaign of creating further awareness of the plight of the construction sector, because "the current state of affairs affects not only those engaged in the construction sector but everyone that is affected by the state of the Namibian

Pre-qualification criteria designed to keep locals out

CEO of the Roads Authority, Conrad Lutombi, has avoided meeting with the CIF or MANWU regarding the road rehabilitation project, despite an original meeting request sent to him on 12 October 2022.

Lutombi did not attend meetings with the CIF at his offices, nor was the KfW invited to attend meetings with the Roads Authority prior to the tender submission deadline

According to the CIF, tenderers on the Karibib-Usakos road project "must have had an unrealistically high turnover averaging N\$150-m annually over the last five years", while the "required cash flow was N\$35-m.

'This is very high and therefore excluded practically all local contractors, especially given the recessionary environment of the last 7 years, which explains why "there were only a very few bona fide Namibian contractors that participated in the tender'

With regard to the technical criteria, "the contractors must have been able to show that they have used different materials - such as Cape Seal, Base, Recycled Base and Fill - in the past. In addition, it was stipulated that in

order to qualify, contractors must have

covered 250,000 m²/year of Cape Seal or Hot Mix asphalt 40 to 50mm and 60,000 m³/year of stabilised recycled

"There is not a single Namibian contractor that has covered the prescribed amount[s] each year over the last 10 years.

"This was a very unrealistic demand, because there has never been a demand of this magnitude in Namibia, not even from the Roads Authority as

"It begs the question, why this has been included as prequalification requirement, when it was not required before, and then knowing full well that local bona fide [contractors] in the past had not been expected to meet those technical requirements before. Why now and for what reason?

The CIF goes on to point out that the fact that the seven short-listed contractors in the TR7/1 project are now required to submit their bids with three Namibian contractors, during the second phase of the tender, "does not justify that majority-owned Namibian contractors were excluded from the

prequalification stage.
"Instead of 100% local content, this method allows only for 25% local

Decline of construction

Namibia's construction sector had been severely impacted since 2016 with the announcement of a moratorium on capital projects by the Government at a time when construction contributed 7.2% to Namibia's GDP. It is now below 2% of GDP.

The CIF and MANWU have been lobbying for an effective regulation of the construction sector through the establishment of a construction industry council since 2006.

"Not only would that support an optimal development of Namibia's construction industry, but it would also lead to an effective utilisation of Government's financial resources and it would also curb the ongoing problem of poor quality workmanship and noncompletion of some of Government

"The CIF has repeatedly also pleaded in their engagement with Namibian authorities that majorityowned Namibian construction companies needed to be more supported. Now one sees that the bulk of civil infrastructure projects as well as social infrastructure projects (e.g. schools, clinics) are being awarded to foreign companies, without any consideration of the plight of Namibia's own construction businesses

"Whilst foreign contractors are being awarded road and building infrastructure projects, Namibia finds that her own businesses have either become dormant, have closed down or needed to declare bankruptcy."

The resulting retrenchments have

approached 50% of the workforce, which "could have been prevented if the projects that were and are being awarded, would exclusively have been considered for majority-owned Namibia contractors

"If the trend of appointing foreign contractors continues, one can expect further closures, further retrenchments and lesser circulation of money in Namibia's economy, and ultimately reduction of Government's potential to collect revenue."

Unless there are urgent reforms, the Namibian government's efforts to attracting foreign direct investment in the Green Hydrogen and fossil fuels sectors will be hampered, resulting in the continuation of Namibian—owned contractors being "pushed aside and displaced due the involvement of foreign contractors"

Foreign construction firms, many of which are multinational, are supported by state subsidies and are therefore able to secure economies of scale and price-competitives.

"From a development perspective the CIF and MANWU [are] also concerned that this financing arrangement with the KfW for the upgrade of the road between Usakos and Karibib cannot be considered as sustainable development if it undermines Namibia's own industry, the CIF concludes.

FLYING HIGH ON SNIFFING AVIATION FUEL

The Namibia Airports Company is facing a lawsuit after it awarded an aviation fuel supply contract worth between N\$74-m and N\$222-million to a company with one employee.

The NAC selected Central Oil Namibia in 2021 to supply fuel at Eros and Andimba Toivo ya Toivo airports over the next 15 years. The contract is valued at an estimated N\$14.8-m annually.

The Namibian's Investigative Unit reported that Social Security Commission records show that Central Oil Namibia was founded in 1989 by George lita and permanently employs only one person.

lita is a former National Central Intelligence Services counterintelligence director and was fired by the NCIS in the 1990s. lita was also involved in a N\$25-m donation to the Democratic Republic of Congo, following Namibia's involvement in the civil war in support of then President Laurent-Desire Kabila.

Central Oil changed ownership in Aug-14 and is now run by George Iita's 33-year old son, Kariapwa lita and his mother Bernadette lita.

Puma Energy, which has over 90 people on its payroll in Namibia has taken legal action against the NAC for awarding the contract, allegedly without following correct procedures. The case has been dragging on since April last year.

The NAC's CEO Bisey /Uirab, has defended the decision to award the fuel contract to Central Oil because Puma failed to show that 51% of the company is owned by Namibians and 30% is owned by previously disadvantaged persons. Puma thus failed to comply with the requirements outlined in the Public Procurement Act 15 of 2015. Puma has dominated most airport fuel contracts for over 30 years, according to /Uirab.

The Namibia Airports Company's award of a N\$222-m aviation fuel supply contract to BEE compliant Central Oil operating out of a house in Katutura with one employee is being challenged by Puma Energy, who has a different take on the Public Procurement Act from that of the NAC, whose website has no record of the contested tender award.

According to information presented before court by the NAC, Puma was also disqualified for not submitting a copy of the Affirmative Action compliance certificate. /Uirab further explained that Puma did not initial all pages of its original bid document and the copies.

'Mischievous questions'

/Uirab also argued that the fi-nance minister had exempted the procurement by public entities for asset disposal, acquisition, rights granting and letting/hiring from the Public Procurement Act. In his view, aircraft fueling services at the airports fall within the category of granting of rights.

Kariapwa lita claimed in court

papers that Central Oil employs 14 people, including three directors and consultants.

He pays three family members N\$65,000 per month, including himself, his mother Bernadette as director and his brother Peter lita as legal advisor. Another N\$65,000 each is paid to director Matheus Shikongo and finance official Tinashe Masvanhise, while operations officer Robert Beukes earns N\$50,000 and logistics officer Hilda Michaels N\$25,000 monthly. Central Oil paid Vaughan Young N\$120,000 to prepare the tender documents.

Karel Gaeb from Sisa Namandje & Co, acting on behalf of the Central Oil directors, declined to comment on The Namibian's "mischievous" questions.

BAD NEWS BREAKING ON TOXIC TENDERS

Former Puma Energy Namibia CEO, Gallo Diack, pointed out in court papers that the tender was not administered by the Central Procurement Board as it ought to have been. Puma argued that bids for consultancy services above N\$20-m [which should be N\$15-m for non-consultancy services judging by the tender reference] have to be dealt with by the CPB, unless an exemption was granted by the finance minister under Section 4(2). According to Diack, Central Oil Namibia lacked capacity and was not known in the industry.

'False aspersions'

lita dismissed Puma's "false aspersions" and claimed that it did not explain why a residential address in Soweto, Katutura should be to the detriment of Central Oil.

In court papers lita also said that Puma did not explain how they arrived at a contract value of N\$74.5-m over five years. According to lita the aircraft fuel provided to the public at the two airports was not above the threshold that NAC could handle. He argued that, based on historical facts, the estimated value of the tender is N\$4.3-m.

If this is per annum, the amount is less than the total salaries paid to the seven staff members mentioned in the court submission,

totaling N\$4.8-m annually. Even at Central Oil's tendered price of N\$4.5-m annually, the total contract value over 15 years would be about N\$64.5-m - above the NAC's procurement value threshold - eds.

The aviation fuel contract at Namibia's main airports has been in the hands of Puma Energy for the past 18 years.

Puma teamed up with Engen and Namcor on a separate tender for aviation fuel at Hosea Kutako International Airport, which is still be adjudicated (The Namibian 02-Jun-23).

Tender background

Tender NCS/ONB/NAC-07/ 2021 for the provision of aircraft fuelling services at Eros and Andimba Toivo ya Toivo Airports closed on 15-Oct-21, after the closing date had been extended from 27-Sep-21. The tender was advertised in some local newspapers and listed in Bulletin 1415 at the time.

Although NAC has a procurement tab on its website with a link to 'awards', no information is accessible on this tender, such as the Bid Evaluation Report. Only a few 'direct procurement' catering tender awards are currently visible.

ANAC award summary page the Tender Bulletin printed in 2022 states that NCS/ONB/NAC-07/ 2021 was awarded to Central Oil Namibia (Pty) Ltd on 18-Jan-22 for through-put charges of N\$0.60 per

liter for both airports.

Tender NAC/HKIA/AF-CS/02/ 2022 for the supply of aviation fuel and aircraft refueling services at Hosea Kutako International Airport closed on 16-Dec-22 and has seemingly not yet been awarded.

NAMIBIA'S 'GO BIG OR GO HOME' ENERGY INDABA

30 JUNE 2023

Namibia's Government Institution Pension Fund has already invested into 105MW of domestic renewables energy projects and intends to add 146MW of generation capacity to its investment portfolio this year.

This was revealed by the GIPF's CEO, David Nuyoma at the 2023 Namibia International Energy Conference in Windhoek in April, according to a press statement by the APO Group on behalf of the NIEC.

As global financial institutions continue to reduce or eliminate fossil fuel lending, emerging producers like Namibia are seeking to drive local and regional financial participation in capital-intensive projects and trade infrastructure.

"It is critical that we find a new pool of liquidity. Most of the European banks are moving away from hydrocarbon financing and this is clearly affecting projects across Africa", said Paul Eardley-Taylor, Southern African Regional Head of Oil & Gas for Standard Bank

Over time, the request from Na-

Namibia's International Energy Conference in April drummed up support for its drive to become a regional energy hub, requiring vast financial resources to to implement capital-intensive energy and infrastructure projects.

mibia will be in the billions of dollars and we will need local banks to ramp up support at every level of the hydro-

carbon value chain."
Claire Hobbs, Chief Treasurer for Bank Windhoek, urged local firms to take a more active role in financing Namibia's energy and infrastructure sectors. It was highlighted that trusted financial partners, firmly rooted within the country, will serve as a requisite for future growth and development

Bank Windhoek MD, Baronice Hans, said: "We need to bring invest-ment into the sector, not only towards fossil fuels, but also towards renewable

opportunities."
Positioning Namibia as a future energy hub within the continent will require significant and diversified investment across the entire energy value chain, backed by international participation. "Companies have had confidence in Namibia, and this includes confidence in the future," said Klaus Endresen, Chairman of the Namibia Petroleum Operators Association.
