(2 – 3 March, 2026)**

Greetings from Services Export Promotion Council!

Hon’ble Prime Minister’s visit of June 2025 marked a milestone in India–Cyprus economic relations. During the visit several high-level MoUs and Expressions of Interest were announced in the fields of Banking, Finance, Technology, Shipping, etc.

Cyprus occupies a unique position as a business and investment hub within the European Union and the Eastern Mediterranean region, offering Indian companies access to EU markets, regional supply chains, and innovation ecosystems. Conversely, India’s rapidly growing economy, large market, and expanding capabilities in manufacturing, technology, Agro-products, pharmaceuticals, chemicals, apparel products, energy, and services present significant opportunities for Cypriot enterprises.

**With this background, High Commission of India will be organizing the India–Cyprus Business & Investment Summit 2026 on 3rd March 2026 at Hilton Nicosia, Cyprus. This Summit is being mounted by the High Commission as a flagship economic diplomacy initiative aimed at further strengthening bilateral trade, investment, and business cooperation between India and Cyprus.**

The Summit is envisaged as a high-level, invitation-only event, bringing together senior Ministers, policymakers, institutional stakeholders, and business leaders across the various sectors. It is designed to serve as a focused platform for dialogue, partnership-building, and identification of concrete collaboration opportunities in strategically important sectors.

The Investment Summit on 3 March 2026 will broadly focus on the following key sectors:

- Renewable Energy and Green Technologies
- Trade and Investment
- IT, FinTech and Digital Services
- Human Capital and Talent
- Supply Chains and Raw Materials

The Summit will be attended by a distinguished audience from Cyprus, including Ministers and senior officials, as well as the leadership of apex business organizations such as Invest Cyprus, the Cyprus Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KEBE), the Cyprus–India Business Association (CIBA), OEB, CIFA, CITEA, and Techisland, in addition to CEOs and senior executives from leading Cypriot companies.

In view of the above, Services Export Promotion Council with the support of High Commission of India, CYPRUS is mounting a Business Delegation to Cyprus to participate in the India–Cyprus Business & Investment Summit 2026, which would significantly enhance the substance and effectiveness of the Summit.

**Keeping in mind the immense business opportunities that exist between India and Cyprus, and the high-level ‘all-in-one place’ platform that the India–Cyprus Business & Investment Summit 2026 meeting provides, I am writing to invite you to join us on this important delegation. Participants will be responsible for their own expenses, including airfare, accommodation, food, and local transportation. An administrative fee of INR 50,000 will be charged to cover organizational costs.**
