Seeking Inputs regarding bilateral trade issues/opportunities vis-a-vis South Korea

Greetings from the Services Export Promotion Council (SEPC)!

As India and South Korea are currently engaged in the renegotiation and upgradation of the India–South Korea CEPA, the Services Export Promotion Council (SEPC) on behalf of Ministry of Commerce, Government of India is compiling industry inputs on key issues and challenges faced by Indian service providers in the South Korean market. These inputs will support ongoing policy discussions while enabling effective representation of industry concerns before the Government.

- iii. Specific examples of Trade barriers pertinent to your sector (like Network usage fees, Indian companies unable to fulfill RFP requirements, etc.)
- iv. Business opportunities relevant to your sector in South Korea
