

## **Request for Proposal**

SEPC is an Export Promotion Council set up by Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India. It is an apex trade body which facilitates service exporters from India. As an advisory body it actively contributes to the formulation of policies of Government of India and acts as an interface between the Services Industry and the Government.

Research organizations are invited to submit proposal for a research study on the export performance of beneficiaries of Services Export from India Scheme (SEIS) from selected cities.

### **Terms of Research:**

- To study the utilization of SEIS scrips for selected beneficiaries
- To study the impact of SEIS on export performance of beneficiaries
- To study the Non-Tariff Measures (NTMs) faced by SEIS beneficiary services exporters
- To study the problems and challenges faced by exporters in availing the benefits of SEIS

The study would be based mainly on primary information to be collected through field surveys of at least 100 beneficiary companies from the top SEIS scrips receiving cities; Delhi, Mumbai, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Chennai, Kolkata.

**Study Duration:** One month

**Eligibility:** The research organization should have proven capability and experience of conducting evaluation studies, field surveys and international trade policy research.
